





Command is an English language training course for pilots to reach, maintain and improve on ICAO levels 4 and 5.

Command focuses on the specific language proficiencies that pilots require for safe RT communications and develops the language skills for success in any test of ICAO English language proficiency for personnel licensing.

To minimise disruption to operations and to fit in around pilot rosters, Command is delivered as self-access e-learning with the option of online instructor-led training.

THE CHALLENGE

- Pilots at ICAO levels 4 and 5 are re-tested for language proficiency at 3 and 6 year intervals
- Re-testing is stressful, and failures are expensive and disruptive to flight operations
- Marginal language proficiency can lead to inefficiencies and is a potential risk to flight safety
- Routine operations may not provide personnel with sufficient opportunity to maintain their language skills leading to a loss of currency
- Finding professional aviation-specific language training that integrates with individual rosters is challenging.

Course description

In line with the recommendations of ICAO document 9835 and circular 323,

Command focuses on language in a range of non-routine situations in flight and ATC operations from depressurisation to fuel shortage, navaid failure to level busts.

The course is delivered in two parts:

- Stand-alone web-based e-learning which trains listening comprehension, structure and vocabulary; and
- Optional Virtual Instructor-Led Training (VILT) sessions with our team of aviation

 demanded by the operational environment. Pilots book sessions to fit in with their

24 units of interactive language activities which focus on:

- Language development and consolidation.
